This is my early (February) 1929 Model A Sport Coupe. These photos of my car were taken in front of the "F. A. Duarte Garage" in Livermore, CA. The garage was built in 1915 and is still in its original location on Portola Avenue, which was once part of the old Lincoln Highway that passed-through town here at this spot.

The Duarte Garage was restored a few years ago by the Livermore Heritage Guild and currently houses their museum, showcasing Livermore's first fire engines from the 1920's. The Guild hosts a monthly "open house", where visitors can view the now-restored fire engines and other artifacts of our town's earlier time. Their website is located at
