

Doc Ingwersen 1923-2013



William F. Ingwersen, better known to family, friends, and the Model A world as "Doc Ingwersen", passed away a few days before his 90th birthday on February 24, 2013. Doc was a gentleman of the first order who always had a smile on his face and kind words for everyone he met.

His involvement in the Model A hobby is legendary. In the late 1980's he and his wife Darlene participated with three other couples on a tour around the world in their Model A's. Doc drove his much-traveled Victoria on the tour. The adventure was published in the *Restorer* at the time. Doc was a life member of MAFCA and served on the Board of Directors. He was also the chairman of the 1990 MAFCA National Meet held in San Diego.

Doc was a graduate of the USC school of dentistry, which was his life long vocation. Doc served in the U.S. Navy as a dentist for forty years (1943 to 1983) retiring in 1983 as a full Captain. At the time, he was the commanding officer of the dental clinic at the Terminal Island Naval Base.

Doc is survived by his wife Darlene and two children.
