
## Remembering Trudy Vestal

She also helped establish the MAFCA Display at the Model A Ford Foundation Museum in Hickory Corners, Michigan. Trudy served as National Meet Chair in 2018 for the convention in Reno/Sparks, Nevada.

Trudy contributed in all areas of her life. She spent countless hours helping at fund-raisers and giving her time to a variety of organizations including the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. She worked for Pacific Bell and the El Dorado County School District in Placerville, California. Students at El Dorado High School said, "She was nice and always helpful."

Trudy often referred to herself as a Georgia peach, having been born in that state. She was the eldest of nine children and played a strong role in the raising of her siblings.
